

## Call for Expressions of Interest

### Community Representative Position Information

#### Background

The Moranbah Cumulative Impacts Group (MCIG) was formed in 2010 to address concerns relating to impacts from expansion and development in Moranbah and its surrounds. The group aims to work together to better understand potential cumulative impacts on the township of Moranbah and to establish confidence in the community that impacts are being addressed and, where possible, mitigated using best practice principles. The MCIG was formed proactively, and by mutual agreement, with a long term view for sustainability.

The group comprises members from industry, Local and State Government, traditional owners and the community. An independent chair was appointed in 2012.

The MCIG is an information sharing group – members share information with each other relating to potential impacts of development from around the region. Information shared relates primarily to the issue of dust.

There is community concern about the cumulative impacts of development on the Moranbah community. In particular, community concern is mostly related to dust – residents anecdotally report of nuisance dust which, in turn, impacts on the liveability of the town. Residents can see the dust in the atmosphere and where it settles on cars, outdoor furniture and washing.

Community understanding of the issue is hampered due to the fact that there is limited reliable air quality data available, as well as a lack of information regarding the potential impact of dust on health. The MCIG aims to be a primary source of reliable air quality data and a primary information source for the community about the potential impact of dust on health. Information and action around broader cumulative impacts will be addressed in the future.

#### About the position

The MCIG is looking for a Community Representative with:

- (i) Good community connections and the ability to represent community interests;
- (ii) Consult with constituents (with support from the MCIG);
- (iii) Provide feedback to the community (with support from the MCIG).
- (iv) A commitment to the purpose and value of MCIG.

As a member of the MCIG, you would be required to attend four meetings per year for a half day in Moranbah. MCIG meetings and papers will always be provided to you prior to the meeting date.

The MCIG Independent Chair and the Project Officer are both available to provide support, training and assistance to you as a Community Representative on the MCIG.


